Howard P. McCollum, 86, of Baton Rouge, LA. was born January 18, 1928 to the union of WA and Sarah Alma Feazell McCollum and passed from this life Thursday November 13, 2014 at Baton Rouge General in the Hospice Butterfly Unit, Baton Rouge, LA. Howard graduated from Northwestern College in Natchitoches, LA. and then continued to Peabody College, Nashville, TN. He was a Mason and served in the United States Army from 1950-1952 as a medical lab technician at Walter Reed Army Medical Center in Washington, DC. and received an honorable discharge in November, 1952 with the rank of Corporal. He began his civilian career at Ferriday High School as a teacher of Biology. Then he held a position as supervisor of science for the state of Louisiana and then returned to Northwestern University as director of supplementary education courses until his retirement. Mr. McCollum is preceded in death by his parents W.A. and Sarah Alma Feazell McCollum, Godchild MiKayla Thibodeaux, brothers Willard McCollum and Wilmer McCollum and sisters Katy Webster, Christine Jean, Johnnie Phillips, Elwin Rials and Delma Flack.
